He/she reflects his/her activities with the purpose of professional development. If necessary, he/she uses counselling and mentors in his/her work and counsels him/herself learners and parents. Teacher, level 7 participates in the development and creative activities of an educational institution as a team member, cooperates with colleagues, support specialists, parents and learners.
