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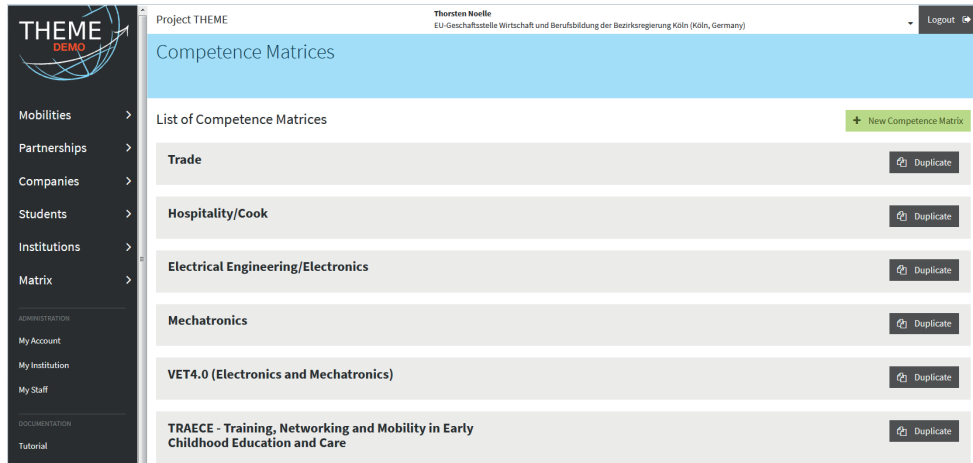
The objectives of the TRAECE project are:

- to provide competences that can be varied or newly defined, e.g. if competences shift in the occupational field due to e.g. digitalization

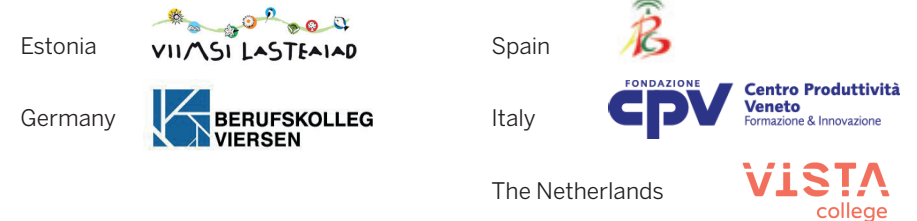
